EXECUTIVE ORDER 01.01.2024.10

Proclaiming an Extended Session of the Maryland General Assembly

WHEREAS, The Budget Bill for Fiscal Year 2025 has not been finally acted upon by the Maryland

General Assembly seven days before the expiration of the 2024 regular legislative

session; and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 52 (10) of the Maryland Constitution provides that under these

circumstances the Governor shall issue a proclamation extending the Session for a period as may, in the Governor's judgment, be necessary to allow for the passage of the

Budget Bill; and

WHEREAS, No matter other than the Budget Bill shall be considered during such extended Session

except a provision for the cost thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WES MOORE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, BY VIRTUE OF

THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY THE CONSTITUTION AND THE LAWS OF MARYLAND, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THAT THE 2024 REGULAR

SESSION OF THE MARYLAND GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS HEREBY

EXTENDED, COMMENCING AT MIDNIGHT ON MONDAY, APRIL 8, 2024 IN THE STATE CAPITAL IN THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PASSING THE STATE BUDGET BILL. THIS EXTENSION MAY NOT EXCEED TEN DAYS, OR SUCH OTHER PERIOD AS SPECIFIED BY AMENDMENT TO

THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER.
