**Rescission of Executive Order 01.01.2024.26**  
**(Declaration of a State of Preparedness - Severe Weather Impact of Hurricane Debby)**

WHEREAS,

I, Wes Moore, Governor of the State of Maryland, issued Executive Order 01.01.2024.26 (Declaration of a State of Preparedness - Severe Weather Impact of Hurricane Debby) on Monday, August 5, 2024, due to the impending threat of severe weather across the State of Maryland; and

WHEREAS,

Having been advised and informed by the Maryland Department of Emergency Management that the threat of severe weather no longer exists as of Saturday, August 10, 2024, and the related risks to Maryland residents have diminished;

NOW, THEREFORE,

I, WES MOORE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF MARYLAND, HEREBY PROCLAIM THAT THE STATE OF PREPAREDNESS IS TERMINATED AND I HEREBY RESCIND EXECUTIVE ORDER 01.02.2024.26, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:
