



EXECUTIVE ORDER 01.01.2025.13

Renewal of Executive Order 01.01.2025.12 (Declaration of a State of Emergency)

WHEREAS, I, Wes Moore, Governor of the State of Maryland, issued Executive Order

> 01.01.2025.12 declaring a State of Emergency as a result of the severe weather that impacted Allegany and Garrett Counties on May 13, 2025;

Because of the on-going impact of this incident, emergency conditions WHEREAS,

continue to exist Statewide;

NOW. I, WES MOORE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, BY THEREFORE.

VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY THE

CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF MARYLAND, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO TITLE 14 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE OF THE MARYLAND CODE, HEREBY DECLARE THAT A STATE OF EMERGENCY CONTINUES TO EXIST WITHIN ALLEGANY AND GARRETT COUNTIES, THAT THE MAY 15, 2025 DECLARATION IS

RENEWED, AND FURTHER PROCLAIM THE FOLLOWING

EXECUTIVE ORDER, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:

- A. The Maryland Department of Emergency Management is hereby directed to continue to coordinate the State response and recovery to impacts of severe weather in Allegany and Garrett Counties.
- B. All other appropriate State authorities are hereby authorized to activate their emergency response and recovery plans for Allegany and Garrett Counties, and engage, deploy, use, and coordinate available resources in furtherance of those plans.
