## TRANSGENDER DAY OF REMEMBRANCE **NOVEMBER 20, 2023**

Transgender Day of Remembrance is an annual observance on November 20 that honors the memory of the WHEREAS, transgender people whose lives were lost in acts of anti-transgender violence; and

Transgender Day of Remembrance was started in 1999 by transgender advocate Gwendolyn Ann Smith as a vigil to WHEREAS, honor the memory of Rita Hester, a transgender woman who was killed in 1998; and

The vigil commemorated all the transgender people lost to violence since Rita Hester's death, and began an important WHEREAS, tradition that has become the annual Transgender Day of Remembrance; and

It is vitally important to remember those whom we have lost, and that we continue to fight for justice; and

The State of Maryland is proud to celebrate our vibrant transgender community and is committed to creating a home WHEREAS, where transgender people thrive.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WES MOORE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim NOVEMBER 20, 2023 as TRANSGENDER DAY OF REMEMBRANCE in Maryland, and do commend this observance to all of our citizens.
