

Proclamation

From the Governor of the State of Maryland

NATIONAL GUN VIOLENCE AWARENESS DAY JUNE 6, 2025

WHEREAS, People in the United States are 26 times more likely to die by gun homicide than people in other high-income countries; and

WHEREAS, Protecting public safety in the communities they serve is among a state lawmaker's highest responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, Support for the Second Amendment rights of law-abiding citizens goes hand-in-hand with keeping guns away from those who are a

danger to themselves or others; and

WHEREAS, Gun violence prevention is more important than ever as we see gun violence continue to impact communities across the country;

and

WHEREAS, National Gun Violence Awareness Day was inspired by Hadiya Pendleton, who was tragically shot and killed, and honors her life

and the many other victims and survivors of gun violence; and

WHEREAS, The idea was inspired by a group of Hadiya's friends, who asked their classmates to commemorate her life by wearing orange; they

chose this color because hunters wear orange to announce themselves to other hunters when out in the woods, and orange is a color

that symbolizes the value of human life; and

WHEREAS, We renew our commitment to reduce gun violence and pledge to do all we can to keep firearms out of the hands of people who

should not have access to them and encourage responsible gun ownership to help keep our families and communities safe.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WES MOORE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim JUNE 6, 2025 as NATIONAL GUN VIOLENCE AWARENESS DAY in Maryland, and do commend this observation to all of our citizens.
