Impacts for Marylanders

\$124 Million

\$124 million in record funding in the budget for the State Aid for Police Protection Fund, used to supplement resources for police protection in our local communities.

Down 44%

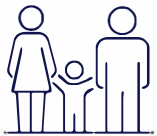
Since the Moore-Miller administration began, homicides are down 44% across the state, a record drop in crime.

180,000 Pardons

Pardons for over 180,000 cannabis possession convictions, helping Marylanders impacted by outdated laws and focusing law enforcement on violent offenders.

4 Straight Years

For the fourth year in a row, homicides and non-fatal shootings are down statewide.



Safer Stronger Together

First-ever full-integration of the Departments of Public Safety & Correctional Services, Human Services, and Juvenile Services to provide care and intervention to families affected by crime or violence in the Safer Stronger Together project.



Funding the Legal System

Sustained investment in both the MD State's Attorney's Association to fund the Prosecutors Academy which ensures a pipeline of new legal talent that can serve our communities, and in the Office of the Public Defender to ensure that those accused of crime have proper representation.



Improved Partnerships

Unprecedented investment in the MD Coordination and Analysis Center, ensuring integration and synchronization with all local, state, and federal law enforcement to enhance situational awareness and drive significant improvements in closure rates.
