The DECADE Act of 2026

- This comprehensive economic development bill broadens Maryland's ability to attract, develop, and grow businesses within our state, including industries of the future.
- The bill makes our state more competitive by modernizing programs and processes to reflect today's rapidly changing economy, including the Build Our Future Grant Program and the RISE Zone Program.
- We are removing barriers to investment, supporting proven programs, and aligning economic development tools for maximum impact.

The Maryland Transit & Housing Opportunity Act

- Leverages at least 300 acres of station-adjacent land, enabling the production of more than 7,000 new housing units and unlocking nearly \$1.4 billion in state and local tax revenue.
- Unlocks underutilized land around high-capacity rail stations for affordable housing and economic growth where people can live, work, and travel.
- Expands financial incentives to build affordable housing alongside rail stations.

The Protection from Predatory Pricing Act

- Prevents Marylanders from being charged different prices for groceries based on personal data.
- Prohibits grocery stores and third party delivery services from using personal data and automated systems to set individual prices for goods.

The Vax Act

- Protects our people by relying on sound science from independent medical organizations to make official recommendations on immunizations, screenings, and other preventative services.
- Prevents political pressure in Washington from reversing decades of standard medical practice.

The Utility RELIEF Act

- A unified strategy between the Moore-Miller Administration and the Maryland General Assembly to hold big companies accountable, modernize our grid infrastructure, and lower energy bills for Maryland families.
- Invests in local clean energy projects, that are the fastest and cheapest way to bring more generation quickly and lower energy costs for Maryland families.
- Increases transparency and accountability for data center companies in the state and ensures they pay for their fair share of energy costs.
