Proclamation

Termination of State of Emergency


WHEREAS, A state of emergency was declared on January 14, 2021, in all Maryland counties and the City of Baltimore to implement the emergency powers of the Governor and protect the lives and property of Maryland citizens; and

WHEREAS, The threat and danger has passed, and the emergency has been dealt with to the extent that the emergency conditions and state of emergency no longer exist;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LAWRENCE J. HOGAN, JR, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY THE CONSTITUTION AND THE LAWS OF MARYLAND, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO TITLES 13 AND 14 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE OF THE CODE OF MARYLAND, HEREBY PROCLAIM THAT THE STATE OF EMERGENCY THAT EXISTED IN ALL MARYLAND COUNTIES AND THE CITY OF BALTIMORE IS TERMINATED.


