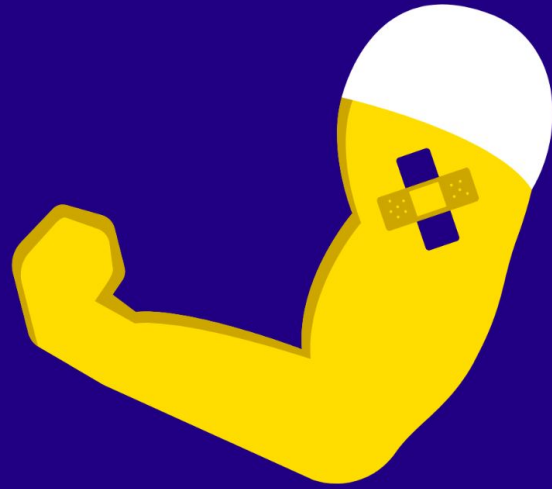

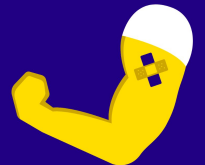

- Conducting clinics at seniors centers with Rite Aid, Safeway, and Giant pharmacies

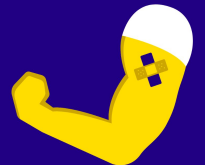

- Working with 42 colleges and universities on social media and ad campaign

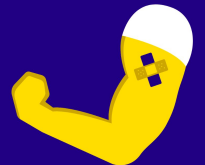

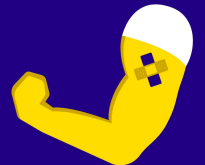
