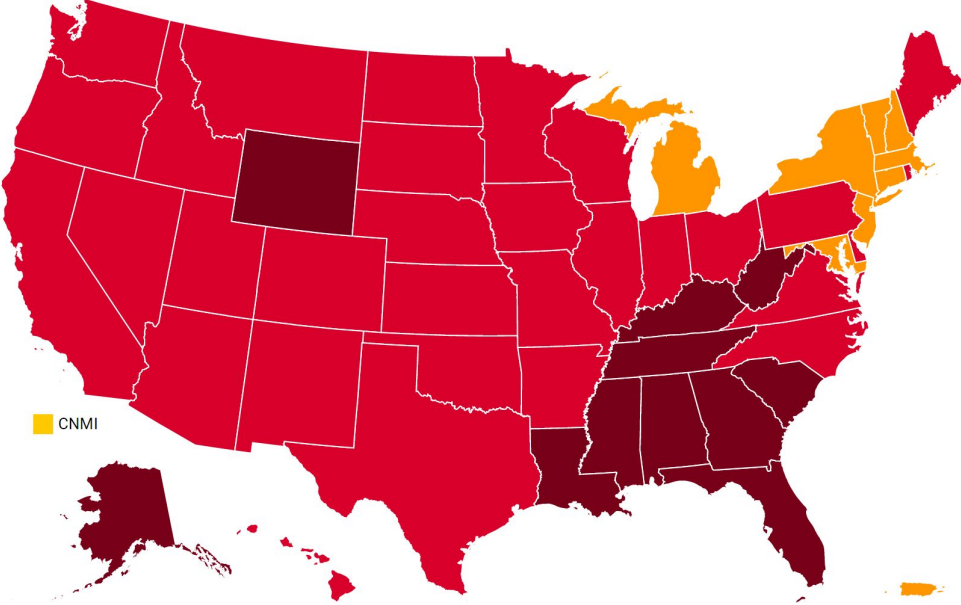

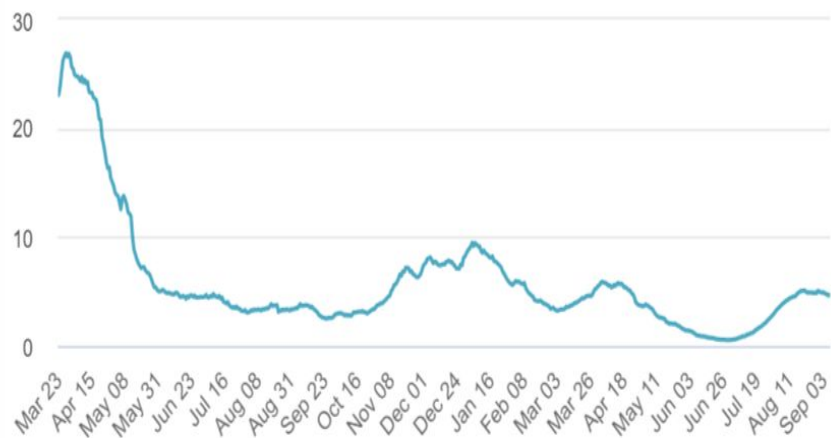

HEALTH METRICS SHOW SIGNS OF LEVELING OFF

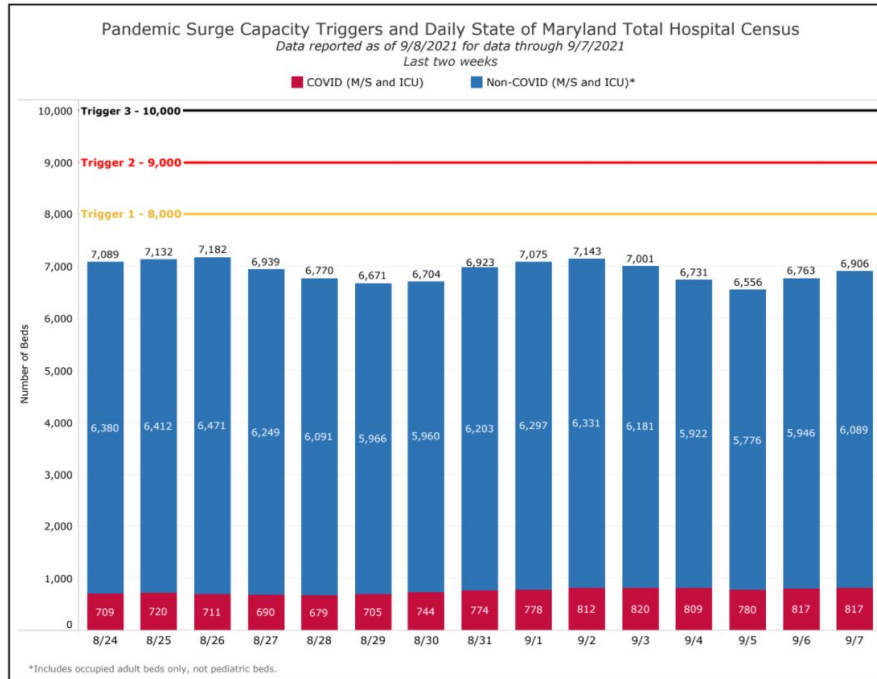


POSITIVITY RATE

Statewide Antibody Testing Program:

- Findings indicate that >60% demonstrated some form of waning immunity over time
- As many as 1 in 3 have a higher level of vulnerability

Effective Immediately:

All Marylanders 65+ living in
congregate care settings are now
eligible for booster shots.



Effective Immediately:

All pharmacies and providers can administer boosters without a prescription or doctor's order to any immunocompromised Marylander.



Community COVID-19 Vaccination Project:

\$3 million statewide canvassing effort to directly engage Marylanders living in areas with low vaccination rates.
