Maryland Global Gateway

This program is the first of its kind offered to small and growing foreign companies looking to explore the U.S. market. Through a growing network of 19 incubators/accelerators, companies can choose Maryland as a “soft landing” location while getting established and developing a network. Incubators/accelerators offer educational programs and training; access to mentors, advisors and entrepreneurs-in-residence; strategic partnerships, and matchmaking.

Program benefits:

As part of \$2 million in funding allotted to the program, the first 50 participating foreign companies can receive the following assistance:

- ▶ Incubator rent costs for up to six months
- ▶ Stipend toward company registration/set-up costs
- ▶ Training
- ▶ Marketing
- ▶ Networking
